Morning Annette,

Further to the reconvened Examination hearings last week, I can confirm that we were happy with the 3.53yr figure put forward by the Councils as a consequence of applying a 5% rather than 20% buffer to Barton Willmore's 5yr HLS table 3.2 (DV32).

In addition, the Inspector also requested the 5% scenario to include all the emerging sites being put forward by the Councils (as referenced in para. 3.17 of DV32).  
The revised figure for this scenario is 5.4yrs worth of supply.
