This brownfield site is currently an unattractive disused farm yard with a collection of former agricultural buildings now falling into disrepair. The land owner has been granted planning consent to convert three of the agricultural buldings into residential dwellings on the western part however this development will leave the majority of the site as brownfield land and unused buildings. We feel that this is the perfect opportunity to extend the residential development on the site from 3 dwellings to up to 10-12 dwellings. This would enable the unattractive former agricultral buildings to be demolished the appearance of the area to be substantially improved whilst also providing low cost housing for local people in what will become an attractive location.
