Our Parish Council is disappointed with these proposals, it would appear that no one at the GNDP has taken the time to examine the previous submissions and concerns expressed in our written evidence.

It would appear these so called modifications put the Population of the NEG T at an even greater disadvantage and Local people would face an even worse situation.

We as a responsible Parish council have put forward strategic and forward looking options that more than meet the genuine housing needs for the NEG T, furthermore we see our proposals would be sustainable and create local jobs for the community.

We must ask where Localism is being considered in these proposals.

We have consistently requested NCC to undertake technical scrutiny of the inner link route options which we believe have significant (CBA) cost benefit analysis and would present a superior time scale implementation in respect to highway construction and early additional housing.
