Currently the applications for Reserved Matters 4 to 7 have yet to be approved. Whilst there is a drainage strategy in place covering all phases, each reserved matters application is still required to discharge the relevant surface and foul water conditions. At the time of writing the Council is not in a position to discharge such conditions on applications for new residential development due to the advice from Natural England regarding Nutrient Neutrality. However, the Council will continue to seek to look for potential solutions for sites where drainage strategies are in place.
